2010 TOURNAMENT PROCEDURES

Just as with last year, let's get our 2010 tournament season off on the right foot, I'll remind all players to time stamp your score-cards immediately after you come off #18 green. AND—do not leave the premises until I have checked your card. If you are in a big hurry, let me know and I'll check your card next. There are just too many times that I find a discrepancy and the player is nowhere to be found to answer questions. To leave early is to risk disqualification.

Another risk is when your group finishes more than 15 minutes behind the preceding group AND have taken more than 4:20 to play the round. If your group violates the above ALL players in that group will be assessed a two stroke penalty. You've had a year to get accustomed to the tournament committee harping at the violators—now let's stay serious and continue playing by the rules.
